Includes (a) 13,283 Restricted Stock Units, each of which represents a contingent right to receive one share of HTZ Common Stock, which will vest on the first, second and third anniversaries of the respective grant dates, subject to the continued employment of the Reporting Person, (b) 2,410 Performance Stock Units ("PSUs"), which were earned following certification of certain financial performance goals by the Issuer's Compensation Committee on March 4, 2019 (the original grant of 9,640 PSUs was awarded on March 2, 2018) and (c) 2,259 PSUs, which were earned following certification of certain financial performance goals by the Issuer's Compensation Committee on March 4, 2020 (the original grant of 9,034 PSUs was awarded on March 4, 2019). The PSUs described in (b) and (c) vest on the third anniversaries of the grant dates, contingent upon the Reporting Person's continued employment and achievement of certain financial performance goals.
